The first line of the following verse can be said as Stationed in the Three, supporting the Seven, born of the Five, She grows. It would also be correct if we said, we grow rather than She grows. Thus the words are very cryptic. While they refer to the actual formation of the River, its origin, its contributing tributaries etc, they also refer to our constitution. The Three then refers to our three shareeras or bodies, the causal, the gross and the subtle collectively known as shareera traya. This passes through the three states or avasthaatraya, the waking, dreaming and sleeping states. The Seven refers to our physical matrix the dhaatus, such as astee bone, rakta blood tissue, medha fatty tissue, majja nerve tissue, tvak epiderma tissuel, shukla secretory and mamsa flesh tissue. The Five refers to the five principles that is the raw material for all births such as agni, vaayu, aap, aakaasa and prithvi. The all round growth of the individual is based on the health of the above. This is related to wealth and nourishment of all kinds. It is this plenitude that is called vaaja. The concluding line requests through invocation the availability of this plenitude again and again. Sarasvati who has been referred to previously as vaajineevati is the one to provide for this.
